

Panshanger Church Stay and Play

Autumn Term 2026

Due to the building works to the chapel it is not practicable to hold Stay and Play in the Community Hall this term.

Stay and Play will instead be taking place in the Church Halls. Please follow the signs past the hall doors with the steps, round the corner to the gate which will be open for step free access through the rear door.

The Church Halls are smaller than the Community Hall so we can only accommodate a maximum of 30 children* with their parents/carers at any session. We will therefore be offering an additional session each week on a Friday allowing us to accommodate the same number of children over the two sessions as we could before.

As we do not want to have to turn people away at the door when our maximum number for any session has been reached you will need to book your children in online in advance each week

Please note children can only attend one session in a week but do not have to attend the same day every week. The good news is that until we are back in the Community Hall we have been able to reduce the cost of Stay and Play to a flat fee of £2 per child
